## About The Meet

India has achieved self sufficiency in food grain, pulses, milk, dairy, poultry sea food etc., however, the scenario of the edible oil production is grim. The Prime Minister’s recent call in covid times to become atmanirbhar has put even more responsibility on researchers to work towards this in a mission mode. Productivity and area expansion has been receiving major emphasis in this regards. Maximum import in agricultural commodities in India is on edible oil (Rs 75000 crores). With the opening of global market import of edible oil has affected the growth of domestic oil industry. Oilseed researchers, industrialists and extension workers need to frame a comprehensive strategy involving all of the major oilseed crop in India (Soybean, groundnut, rapeseed & mustard, oil palm, castor, linseed, sunflower etc.) for self sufficiency. Oil seed Institutes under ICAR have been working for the development and dissemination of technologies among stakeholders and these need to reach the end users at a faster pace. This interface meeting is planned to bring all the stakeholders under one umbrella for discussing the present status, gaps and constraints in order to make a robust road map. It is envisaged that the outcome from the meet will not only help guide future research plans but also bridge the productivity gap through transfer of technologies and enumerate policy issues for government intervention. Based on the outputs of the interface meet, it is planned to , it is planned prepare a “Road Map for edible Oil self-Sufficiency” that will guide the future path.
